29. A naval brigade shall be composed of two battalions, each battalion to consist of not more than three divisions. Five divisions shall be composed of the following:

- 1 Lieutenant, Senior Grade.
 - 1 Lieutenant, Junior Grade.
 - 1 Ensign.
 - 2 Boatswain Mates.
 - 2 Quartermasters.
 - 1 Master at Arms.
 - 2 Gunners' Mates.
 - 2 Coxswains.
 - 1 Yeoman.
 - 44 Seamen and Apprentice Seamen.
- Total enlisted, 54 petty officers and men.
The minimum strength of a division shall be 36 petty officers and men.

There shall be one division which shall consist of:

- 1 Chief Engineer, Lieutenant.
 - 1 Past Assistant Engineer, Lieutenant, Junior Grade.
 - 1 Assistant Engineer, Ensign.
 - 3 Chief Machinists.
 - 4 Electricians.
 - 1 Chief Yeoman.
 - 47 Machinists' Mates, who shall be appointed as oilers.
Water Tenders and Firemen.
- Total enlisted, 54 petty officers and men.

The brigade shall be officered as follows:

- 1 Captain.
- 1 Commander.
- 1 Lieutenant Commander.
- 1 Navigation and Signal Officer, Lieutenant.

The staff shall consist of:

- 1 Surgeon, Lieutenant.
- 1 Assistant Surgeon, Lieutenant, Junior Grade.
- 1 Paymaster, Lieutenant.
- 1 Assistant Paymaster, Lieutenant, Junior Grade.
- 1 Chaplain, Lieutenant.

The warrant officers of the brigade shall be:

- 1 Boatswain.
- 1 Gunner.
- 1 Carpenter.
- 1 Pay Clerk.
- 1 Machinist.

The chief petty officers of the brigade shall be:

- 1 Chief Master-at-Arms.
- 1 Chief Boatswain's Mate.
