

## ARTICLE XLIV.

### HOSPITAL—MARYLAND.

"The State Omnibus Loan of 1914" was authorized by the act of 1914, chapter 791, and out of the proceeds, \$80,000 was apportioned to the Spring Grove State Hospital. See article 31, section 45, *et seq.* and footnote.

"The State Omnibus Loan of 1914" was authorized by the act of 1914, chapter 791, and out of the proceeds, \$110,000 was apportioned to the Springfield State Hospital. See article 31, section 45, *et seq.* and footnote.

As to the loan of eight hundred thousand dollars, one hundred and seventy-five thousand dollars thereof for the erection and construction of additional buildings at the Springfield State Hospital, see the act of 1912, chapter 187; see also articles 31 and 59 of this code.

By the act of 1912, chapter 417, four thousand dollars was appropriated for the purchase of land adjoining Springfield State Hospital, and the purchase of said land was approved as of the date of payment and acceptance of deed.

By the act of 1912, chapter 430, the Governor was authorized to appoint a policeman to preserve order upon the property of the Springfield State Hospital.

19.

The act of 1912, chapter 441, appropriated twenty-five thousand dollars for the erection of a hospital in Frostburg to be known as the Miners' Hospital, provided for directors, and the operation and maintenance thereof.

By the act of 1914, chapter 791, "The State Omnibus Loan of 1914" was created and the proceeds were apportioned in part as follows: To the Springfield State Hospital, \$110,000; to the Spring Grove State Hospital, \$80,000; to the Crownsville State Hospital, \$100,000; to the Eastern Shore State Hospital, \$100,000; to the Rosewood State Training School, \$28,000. See article 31, section 45, *et seq.* and footnote.

As to the loan of eight hundred thousand dollars for the erection and construction of additional buildings for the hospitals for the insane and feeble-minded of Maryland, and for the erection and construction of buildings and the purchase of land for the Eastern Shore State Hospital, see articles 31 and 59 of this code.
