An Act legalizing the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, edited by Horace E. Flack, and making it evidence of the law.

Whereas, A new edition of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland has been prepared by Horace E. Flack, in pursuance of Chapter 311 of the Acts of 1927; therefore

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, edited by Horace E. Flack, be and the same is hereby legalized and shall be deemed and taken in all the Courts of the State, and by all Justices of the Peace of the State, and by all other public officials therein, to be evidence of the Public Local Laws of the State contained in the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland of 1888 and the Public Local Laws enacted subsequent thereto; provided that before the said Code is published, the Public Local Laws enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland at its session of 1929 shall be incorporated therein.
