

**Painted Numbers for Dredging Vessels.**

35. License numbers; application of section; penalty.

**Dredging in Exempted Waters.**

36. Sailing in exempted waters unlawful. Officers to arrest offenders.

**State Fishery Force.**

37. Ammunition for guard boats to carry out this provision.
38. Waters to be divided into seven districts. Counties included in each district. Guards for each district.
39. Board of public works to appoint commander and deputies of fishery force. Term of office. Penalty for failure to discharge duty. Who not eligible for said offices.
40. Removals for neglect of duty.
41. Powers of board of public works in matter of reducing expenses of state fishery force.
42. Vessels to be constantly on duty.
43. Duty of deputy commanders.
44. Oath and bond of officers of state fishery force.
45. Salaries of various officers of state fishery force.
46. One ration per day for officers and crews. Appropriation; proviso.
47. Duties of officers of oyster police force.
48. State fishery force to enforce all laws relating to fish.
49. Commander to have control of force, to keep accounts and make report to board of public works. Clerk to said commander—his salary.

**Locating Oyster Lots.**

50. Private oyster planting. Notice to owner. Marking off beds. These provisions not to apply to non-residents.
51. Unlawful to locate or appropriate any natural bed or bar; penalty.
52. Exclusive right to creeks 100 yards or less in width.
53. Taking bedded oysters, unlawful. Penalty for violating secs. 25 and 53.
54. Right of appeal.

**Craighill Channel.**

55. Dredging near Craighill channel unlawful; penalty.

**Patuxent.**

56. Time when oysters may not be taken in.
57. Penalty for violation.

**Patuxent—Potomac—Choptank.**

58. When oysters may not be taken in Patuxent, Potomac and Choptank Rivers and tributaries; proviso.
- 59-61. What privileges granted in license to citizens of St. Mary's, Charles and Calvert Counties.
62. Penalties for violating secs. 58 to 61.
63. Dredging prohibited in part of Choptank River and tributaries.
64. Only citizens of Maryland and Virginia may take oysters, etc.
65. Closed season for taking oysters with scoop, tongs, etc.
66. Culling; penalties; proviso.
67. Open season for taking oysters; dredging other than from sail boat prohibited; penalty.
68. Permit for buying and taking away oysters for planting purposes; conditions; penalty.
69. Dredging in Potomac River prohibited.
- 70-71. Offenses, by whom punished; penalties; forfeitures.
72. Failure of oyster inspector to report violations of law.
73. Compact with Virginia not impaired.

**General Measurers and Inspectors.**

74. Appointment; assignment; bond; power and authority.
- 75-76. Special inspectors; oath; duties; inspection charge; duties of transportation companies. Presumption as to oysters found within state. Form of certificate.
77. Permit to take oysters out of state; inspection tax; penalty.
78. Severability clause.
79. Inspection districts; powers of conservation commission. Report of packers and commission merchants; oath.
80. Duties and powers of general measurers and inspectors.
81. Salaries of general measurers and inspectors; removal. Penalties; reports.
82. How oysters shall be measured; dimensions of tub; penalty.
83. Penalty for charging more than one-half cent per bushel.
