AN ACT to make valid the last will and testament of a certain John Hanna, late of late of the State of Pennsylvania, deceased.

WHEREAS, a certain John Hanna, late of the State of Pennsylvania, deceased, did by his last will and testament devise certain real estate, situated in Cecil county, Maryland, unto his son Benjamin Hanna, which said will was not executed in conformity with the laws of the State of Maryland, being attested by only two subscribing witnesses, and for remedy therefor,

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That all devises of real estate in the State of Maryland, made by said testator, in his said will are hereby ratified and made valid, and to have the same effect in law and equity, as if the said will had been attested by three subscribing witnesses in conformity to the laws of the State of Maryland.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from its passage.
