

for Worcester county, in all cases which may hereafter be tried in said county, the fees following, to wit: in every case of murder, arson or rape, twenty-five dollars; in every case of felony, other than murder, arson or rape, twenty dollars; in every case of misdemeanor punishable, if the party charged be a white man, by confinement in the penitentiary, or if a negro, by sale, ten dollars; and in all other misdemeanors, five dollars; said fees to be in addition to the regular appearance fees now allowed by law.
