

122. The value of the land and the damages assessed, shall, upon final ratification, and after the erection of a suitable school-house thereon, be paid by order of the board of school commissioners out of the school fund; *provided* such value and damages shall not exceed thirty dollars, but all other costs accruing from such condemnation shall be provided for by the trustees.

BRIDGE OVER EAST BRANCH OF WICOMICO RIVER.
