The clerk of each district shall give at least ten days' previous notice of the time and place and purposes of holding such annual meeting, to the taxable inhabitants of the district, by advertisement set up at three of the most public places therein. The levy made by the county commissioners for the purposes of primary schools, including books, stationery and fuel for the year eighteen hundred and sixty, is hereby legalized and made valid in law, and shall be collected in the same way as all other taxes are collected.
