

CHAP.

- To appropriate a sum of money to pay the Electors of President and Vice-President of the United States, in and for the State of Maryland, their officers and attendants, 107
- To direct the Comptroller to issue his warrant to the Treasurer to pay to George Colton & Son, the sum of twenty-four hundred ninety-five dollars and forty-seven cents, 124
- To authorize the Faculty and Board of Trustees of the Washington University of Baltimore, to use the real estate of said University, situated at the corner of Calvert and Saratoga streets, in Baltimore city, as a basis of credit to raise a sum of money not exceeding ten thousand dollars, by creating a ground rent thereon for the uses of said University, 126
- To authorize John T. Waller, guardian, to settle his accounts as guardian to Charles N. Waller, and to deliver over the estate to his said ward, 147
- For the relief of Daniel Ammen, of Anne Arundel county, and authorizing the Commissioners of said county to correct the errors in his assessment, 159
- To authorize the Roman Catholic Archbishop of Baltimore to sell a certain parcel of land, 166
- To authorize the County Commissioners of Carroll county to indemnify William Shaw for the destruction of his property in the city of Westminster by a mob in April, eighteen hundred and sixty-five, and to levy a sum of money for the payment of such indemnity, 172
- To authorize the Adjutant General to furnish arms for the use of the Maryland Agricultural College, 183
- To appropriate the sum of *forty-nine* thousand two hundred and ninety-six dollars and twenty eight cents, to pay the various mechanics and others the amounts due them for work and labor done and materials furnished, in the erection of the Governor's Mansion, at Annapolis, and the enclosure and improvement of the grounds surrounding the same, 207
- To repeal an Act, entitled "an Act to appropriate a sum of money to be expended in removing the remains of the Confederate dead who fell in the Battles of South Mountain, Crampton's Gap, Antietam and Monocacy," 213
- To authorize Joshua Motter and Samuel Motter, or either of them, to convey all the right, title, interest and claim of the German Reformed Congregation, at Emmitsburg, in Frederick county, in and to the Elias Church property, to the Evangelical Lutheran Congregation or their legal representatives, 218
