

ARTICLE XXVII.

CRIMES AND PUNISHMENTS.

Boundaries.

21A. Wanton trespass upon private land; penalty; proviso.

Counterfeiting and Forgery.

32. Private instruments, penalty. This section not to affect past offences or pending indictments.

Cruelty to Animals.

46E. Disposition of fines Arrests may be made on view by officers of society.

46J. Appraisement of diseased or disabled animals, how and by whom made. Certificate of, under oath.

Disturbances of the Public Peace

67. Penalty for obstructing the free passage of persons or disturbing the public peace by unseemly noises or profane or obscene language. Jurisdiction of justices of the peace. Section not to apply to Baltimore city.

119F. Articles whose component parts are made of the same metal, soldered together, stamped coin or coin silver, to contain nine hundred one-thousandths of pure silver.

119G. Metal mounting of articles with metal mounting, stamped sterling or sterling silver, to contain not less than nine hundred and twenty-five one-thousandths of pure silver.

119H. Metal mounting of articles stamped coin or coin silver to contain not less than nine hundred one-thousandths of pure silver.

119I. Case or covering of articles composed of works or movements stamped sterling or
