

- 60. Transportation of the diseased trees, etc., a misdemeanor; penalty.
- 61. Plants to be fumigated.
- 62. All plants shipped must be labelled. Certificate of inspection to be shown. Duty of officers when provisions of this sub-title are violated.
- 63. Penalty for shipping without certificate. Fines to be paid into the fund appropriated for carrying out these provisions. Infested trees so shipped to be destroyed.
- 64. Annual report of officers.
- 65. Report to be published.
- 66. Appropriations for carrying out the provisions of this sub-title.
- 67. Warrant for such appropriations. Amount to whom payable.

Tree and Fruit Inspectors.

- 68. Penalty for allowing trees infested with "yellows" to continue on premises.
- 69. Such trees to be destroyed. No damages shall be awarded for such destruction.
- 70. Appointment of "tree and fruit inspectors."
