

## CHAPTER 72.

AN ACT to repeal sections two hundred and twenty-nine, two hundred and thirty, and two hundred and thirty-one of article four of the Code of Public Local Laws, relating to "Fines and Forfeitures," for the violation of ordinances of the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That sections two hundred and twenty-nine, two hundred and thirty, and two hundred and thirty-one of article four of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "City of Baltimore," subtitle "Fines and Forfeitures," be and the same are hereby repealed.

## CHAPTER 73.

AN ACT to prevent the capture of rabbits by looping or snaring in districts numbers eight and eleven of Washington county.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That hereafter it shall not be lawful for any person to capture or take any rabbit in districts numbers eight and eleven of Washington county, by the contrivances commonly called snaring or looping, and any person offending against the provisions of this act shall forfeit and pay a fine of ten dollars for each and every such offence, to be recovered before a justice of the peace of the district in which such offence may be committed, one-half of said fine to go to the informer and the other half to the county commissioners for the use of the public schools of the county.
