

CHAPTER 90.

AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money as additional compensation to Henry Page for services in the case of the State of Maryland *vs.* Lillian Duer.

WHEREAS Henry Page was appointed by the Circuit Court for Worcester county assistant counsel for the State in the case of the State against Lillian Duer, and as such rendered services in the trial of said cause which have not been compensated, and whereas there accrued to the said State the sum of five hundred dollars imposed as a fine and collected from said defendant.

Preamble.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Treasurer, upon the warrant of the Comptroller, is hereby directed to pay to Henry Page aforesaid, the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars, as additional compensation in the case of the State *vs.* Lillian Duer, to be paid out of any moneys in the treasury not otherwise appropriated.

Pay additional compensation.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
