

CHAPTER 299.

AN ACT to amend chapter three hundred and twenty-five of the acts passed at the January session, eighteen hundred and seventy-eight, entitled an act to repeal chapter two hundred and fourteen of the acts passed at January session of eighteen hundred and seventy-four, relating to catching oysters with scoops in Dorchester county, and to re-enact the same with amendments, by adding an additional section.

Act amended

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That an act, entitled an act to amend chapter three hundred and twenty-five of the acts passed at the January session, eighteen hundred and seventy-eight, entitled an act to repeal chapter two hundred and fourteen of the acts passed at January session of eighteen hundred and seventy-four, relating to catching oysters with scoops in Dorchester county, and to re-enact the same with amendments, be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows :

Captains to
arrest.

SEC. 13. *And be it enacted,* That the captains of every licensed canoe, boat or vessel under this act, shall be a police officer for making special arrests, and the School Commissioners of Dorchester county are hereby authorized to allow any such captain one-half the fine that is paid to the said board for arrests made by him of non-residents taking or catching oysters in the waters of said county.
