

CHAPTER 308.

AN ACT appropriating a sum of money to pay Thomas H. Walls, late collector of taxes for the second election district of Queen Anne's county, the amount overpaid by him into the treasury.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Comptroller be and he is hereby authorized to issue his warrant upon the Treasurer to pay to Thomas H. Walls, of Queen Anne's county, the sum of fifteen dollars and thirty-six cents, payment thereof being recommended by the officers of the Treasury Department, being the amount overpaid by him into the treasury as collector of taxes for the second election district of Queen Anne's county, for the year eighteen hundred and seventy-seven.

Issue warrant.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. **Effective.**

CHAPTER 309.

AN ACT to change a portion of the dividing line between the third and fifth election district of Garrett county.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the present dividing line between the third and fifth election districts of Garrett county be changed so as to run as follows: Beginning at the top of Negro Mountain where the road known as the Samuel Engle Mill road crosses said mountain, and running thence with the said road to the Westerman bridge over the Cashl-man river, thence with the said river to the point where it in-
