

tigation of such service and render an impartial award, which said board of reference shall consider and determine the value of the services rendered by this corporation, and shall make their award setting forth the same, which award shall be in writing, signed and sworn to by them; when the value of the services rendered by this corporation in any case is thus ascertained, this corporation is empowered to sue for and recover the same, as in the case of any other debt due the corporation.

How managed. SEC. 7. *And be it enacted*, That the affairs of the corporation shall be managed and controlled by a board of management, which board shall be elected by ballot annually, by the members of this corporation; the board shall then elect its own officers, and have power from time to time to adopt such by-laws as may be deemed necessary for the government of the corps, not inconsistent with the laws of this State, and to alter such by-laws at its discretion.

Effective. SEC. 8. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 349.

AN ACT to repeal sections forty-one, forty-two and fifty-six of the Code of Public General Laws, article fifty-six, entitled "License," sub-title "Traders," and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Repealed and re-enacted. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That sections forty-one, forty-two and fifty-six of the Code of Public General Laws, article fifty-six, entitled "Licenses," sub-title "Traders," be and the same are hereby repealed and re-enacted with amendments so as to read as follows:
