SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the said president and directors, or a majority of them, are hereby authorized to subscribe to, purchase and hold, any portion of the capital stock or securities of the North Baltimore Passenger Railway Company of Baltimore county, a corporation duly incorporated under the act of eighteen hundred and sixty eight, chapter four hundred and seventy-one, and now operating its said passenger railway from Waverly, in Baltimore county, to the north boundary of Baltimore city, and forming in fact a connecting line with the railway of said president and directors.

Change of
name.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That the corporate name of the said Baltimore, Peabody Heights and Waverly Passenger Railroad be and the same is hereby changed to the name of the North Baltimore Passenger Railway Company.

How effective

SEC. 4. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect so soon as it shall be assented to by three-fourths of the capital stock of said company voting at a general meeting of stockholders lawfully assembled.
