

quest of one thousand dollars to the "Little Sisters of the Poor" in the city of Baltimore; fourth, the bequest of one thousand dollars to "St. Mary's Female Orphan Asylum" in the city of Baltimore; fifth, the bequest of one thousand dollars to "St. Vincent of Paul's Benevolent Association," commonly known as "St. Vincent's Male Orphan Asylum" in the city of Baltimore; sixth, the bequest of one thousand dollars to the "House of Good Shepherd" in the city of Baltimore; seventh, the bequest of one thousand dollars to "St. Francis' Orphan Asylum" in the city of Baltimore; eighth, the bequest of one thousand dollars to the "Boys Home Society of Baltimore" in the city of Baltimore; ninth, the bequest of one thousand dollars to the "Baltimore Orphan Asylum" of the city of Baltimore; tenth, the bequest of one thousand dollars to the "Maryland Academy of Sciences" in the city of Baltimore; eleventh, the bequest of one thousand dollars to the "Colored Orphans' Home" in the city of Baltimore; twelfth, the bequest of one thousand dollars to the "Hebrew Hospital and Asylum Association" in the city of Baltimore; thirteenth, the bequest of ten thousand dollars to the "Maryland Institute" for the promotion of the mechanics arts for the use of its school of design in the city of Baltimore.

CHAPTER 148.

AN ACT to authorize and direct the governor to appoint an additional justice of the peace for Montgomery county.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the governor be and he is hereby authorized and directed to appoint an additional justice of the peace for Damascus district, or district number twelve, in Montgomery county. Justice.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. Effective.
