

Exempt. That the waters of Dickinson's bay and Reed's creek in Talbot county, tributaries of the Choptank river, be exempt from the provisions of article ninety-nine, section two, of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland.

Decoys. SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That it shall not be lawful to place decoys in said waters during the hours intervening between twilight in the evening and twilight in the morning.

Fine. SEC. 3. *And be it enacted,* That any person or persons violating the provisions of section two of this act, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and on conviction thereof before a justice of the peace, shall pay a fine of ten dollars for each and every offense, and on failure to pay said fine, shall be lodged in jail for ten days.

Paid. SEC. 4. *And be it enacted,* That one-half of said fine collected under the provisions of this act, shall be paid by the justice of the peace to the informer, and the remaining half to the school commissioners for the use of public schools in the district in which said violation occurred.

Effective. SEC. 5. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 3.

AN ACT to repeal sections seven, eight, nine, ten, thirteen, fourteen, fifteen, sixteen, twenty-one and twenty-three, of Article eight, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Cecil County," sub-title "Almshouse," and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Repeal. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland* That sections seven, eight, nine, ten, thirteen, fourteen, fifteen, sixteen, twenty-one and twenty-three, of article eight, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Cecil County," sub-title "Almshouse," be and the same are hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows :

Terms of service. SEC. 7. On the second Tuesday in February, eighteen hundred and ninety, the county commissioners of Cecil county shall appoint three discreet and competent persons, residents of said county, not more than two of whom shall be adherents of the same political party, trustees of the poor and insane of Cecil county, for the following terms: one trustee to serve for six years, one for four years, and one for two years, from the second
