

lation of any provisions of this act, or any ordinance or by-law passed in pursuance thereof, and for all taxes levied upon dogs kept within the corporate limits of said town, as well as for the faithful discharge of his duties as bailiff.

SEC. 63. *And be it enacted*, That whenever a tax, other than a dog tax is levied, the same shall be placed in the hands of a collector appointed for the purpose, or one of the bailiffs, in the discretion of the commissioners, and bond shall be given by said collector or bailiff to the commissioners of Cambridge, in the penalty of double the amount of said tax levy, with a surety or sureties to be approved by the commissioners for the faithful collection and payment into the treasury said levy. #### CHAPTER 438.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments section one hundred and eighteen, of article twenty-five, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "County Commissioners," sub-title "Public Landings," and to re-enact the same with amendments.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That section one hundred and eighteen, of article twenty-five, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "County Commissioners," sub-title "Public Landings," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted with amendments so as to read as follows: Repeal

118. In all cases when the public convenience requires it the county commissioners shall have power to establish a public landing upon any navigable river, canal, bay, sound or other navigable waters. Establish.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. Effective.
