130. Said board shall consist of five persons, a president and four commissioners, who shall be citizens of the United States at least twenty-five years of age, and *bona fide* residents of said town for at least two years next preceding the date of their election, and shall each in his own right, or in the right of his wife, own real estate in the town assessed at not less than six hundred dollars; and all male citizens of the United States above twenty-one years of age who shall own property assessed in the limits of the town and shall have paid their tax, and all male inhabitants of the town citizens of the United States, above twenty-one years of age, who shall have *bona fide* resided in the town two years next preceding the election, at which they shall offer to vote shall be shall be entitled to vote for said president and commissioners.

SEC. 130 A. On the second Monday in April, eighteen hundred and ninety, (and on the same date biennially thereafter,) said voters shall elect a president of said board, who shall serve for the two years thence ensuing, or until his successor is duly elected and qualified; also on the second Monday of April, eighteen hundred and ninety, said voters shall elect four commissioners for terms to be determined as follows: as soon as said commissioners have been elected and qualified they shall by lot divide themselves into classes, two of said commissioners to serve for two years from the date of their election, or until their successors are elected and qualified, and two to serve for one year from the date of their election, or until their successors are duly elected and qualified; and on the second Monday of April, eighteen hundred and ninety-one, and on that date annually thereafter, said voters shall elect two commissioners to serve for two years from the date of their election, or until their successors are elected and qualified.

131. The president and commissioners of said town shall annually designate the time and place of holding said election, and
