

## CHAPTER 298.

AN ACT to regulate the institution of suits before justices of the peaces in Kent County.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That upon any cause of action within the jurisdiction of a justice of the peace arising in Kent County, it shall not be lawful for any resident of said county to be sued before any justice of the peace other than in the election district in which he, she, or they may reside, provided, however, that nothing in this act shall be construed to prevent the institution of suits before a justice of the peace in the election district wherever the contract, bargain or sale was made, or cause of action originated. Where to  
be sued.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That all acts or part of acts contrary to or in conflict with the provisions of this act, be and the same are hereby repealed. Repeal.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. Effective.

## CHAPTER 299.

AN ACT to repeal section eight of article nineteen of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Comptroller," and to re-enact the same with amendments.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That section eight of article nineteen of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Comptroller," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted with amendments to read as follows : Amend-  
ment.

SEC. 8. He may employ a clerk, whose compensation shall be eighteen hundred dollars per annum, and four assistant clerks, whose compensation shall be twelve hundred dollars each per annum. Clerks

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. Effective.
