

Joseph's Diocesan Orphan Asylum at Cold Springs, Campbell County, Kentucky; to the House of the Good Shepherd on the Highlands, Campbell County, Kentucky; to Saint Elizabeth's Hospital on Eleventh street, Covington, Kentucky; to the Little Sisters of the Poor; to the Sisters of the Good Shepherd, in trust; to the Sisters of Mercy, in trust; to the Sisters of Charity, in trust; to Saint Francis' Hospital for Incurables at Fairmount, Cincinnati, Ohio; to the Little Sisters of the Poor of Saint Francis, in trust; to the Most Reverend William Henry Elder, Archbishop of Cincinnati, or his successor, in trust.

*Second.* To the bequest contained in the will of Miles Crow, late of Harford County, Maryland, on file and of record in the office of the Registrar of Wills of said county, of the sum of five hundred dollars to the Reverend Francis M. Fowler, or his successors, for the use of the choir of Saint Ignatius' Catholic Church, at the Hickory, Harford County, aforesaid.

*Third.* To the bequests contained in the will of Joseph E. Robinson, late of Harford County, Maryland, deceased; and of record in the office of the Register of Wills of Harford County aforesaid, of the sum of two hundred dollars to the trustees of Ebenezer Methodist Episcopal Church, situated in the fourth election district of Harford County aforesaid, and one hundred dollars to the Board of Foreign Missions of the Methodist Episcopal Church of the Maryland Conference.

*Fourth.* To the bequest contained in the last will and testament of Sarah Varnes, late of Harford County, Maryland, deceased, on file and of record in the office of the Register of Wills of Harford County, of the sum of five hundred dollars to the trustees of the Old School Baptist meeting house and grounds (called the Harford Church), in Harford County aforesaid.

*Fifth.* To the bequest contained in the will of John Watkins, late of Harford County, Maryland, on file and of record in the office of the Register of Wills of said county, of forty dollars to the Harford Baptist meeting house or burying grounds in Harford County aforesaid.

*Sixth.* To the bequest contained in the last will and testament of Barbara M. Beall, late of Anne Arundel County, deceased, of two thousand dollars to the Convention of the Protestant Episcopal Church of the Diocese of Maryland.

*Seventh.* To the bequest heretofore made by Benjamin Langford, late of Somerset County, deceased, to the "Trustees of Antioch Methodist Episcopal Church," that is
