CHAPTER 48.

AN ACT to limit the session of the grand jury in Baltimore County.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the limit of the session of the grand jury in Baltimore County shall be ten days, but the Court may for special reasons extend the session for five days longer. Session of Grand Jury.

CHAPTER 49.

AN ACT to repeal sections one hundred and eighty-eight to two hundred and seventeen inclusive of article three of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Baltimore County," sub-title "Roads," and to enact the following in lieu thereof.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That sections one hundred and eighty-eight to two hundred and seventeen inclusive, of article three of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Baltimore County," sub-title "Roads," be and the same are hereby repealed, and the following provisions be substituted therefor.

SEC. 188. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the County Commissioners of Baltimore County at their meeting next after the passage of this act, and at their first meeting in January in every year thereafter, shall appoint one road supervisor in each election district, to act as such for one year from the time of his appointment, or until his successor shall qualify, except in the case of appointment made in the year 1892, whose term shall extend to the next annual appointment as herein provided; who shall give bond to the County Commissioners conditioned for the faithful performance of his duties in a sum equal to the amount of the general road tax levied from the district for which he is appointed, and who shall be paid such reasonable salary as
