

Mr. Carter, from the Committee on the Judiciary, reported unfavorably,

House bill entitled an Act to restrict the appointment of officials in the public institutions of the State of Maryland, and to the city of Baltimore, to legal residents of the State of Maryland.

Which was adopted.

Also, favorably,

House bill entitled an Act to add an additional section to Article 43, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Health," sub-title "Insurances," to follow section 38, and to be designated "38 A."

Mr. Bryan moved to indefinitely postpone further consideration of said bill.

Which motion prevailed.

Also, favorably,

House bill entitled an Act to repeal and re enact section 42, Article 21, Code of Public General Laws, title "Conveyancing," sub-title "Bills of Exchange."

Which was read a second time, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

Also, unfavorably,

House bill entitled an Act to add three sections providing for the review by the courts of disputed assessments to Article 26, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Courts," to follow section 41 of such title.

Which was adopted.

Also, favorably, with proposed amendment,

House bill entitled an Act to repeal and re enact with amendments section 68, of Article 27, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Drunkenness and Disorderly Conduct."

AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

"Provided no portion of this Act shall apply to Carroll county."

Which was adopted.

Said bill, as amended, was then read a second time, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.
