House bill entitled an Act to amend chapter 542, of the Acts of 1890, entitled an Act to change the name of the Trust, Deposit, Loan, Security, Guarantee and Insurance Company of Baltimore county, and to enlarge the powers of said corporation, and also to amend the original Act of incorporation of said company.

Was read a third time, and failed for want of a constitutional majority, by yeas and nays, as follows :
