Resolved, That Charles S. Parran, on the 3d day of November, 1891, was elected Register of Wills for Calvert county for the term of six years, and is entitled to the office of Register of Wills of said county now filled by him for said term.

Resolved, That the petitions and memorials of Richard A. Bafford, Walter H. Allton and Samuel L. Gibson, asking to have awarded to them the office of Judges of the Orphans' Court of Calvert county, as also the petition and memorial of B. B. D. Bond, asking to have awarded him the office of Clerk to the Circuit Court of Calvert county, as also the petitions and memorials of James C.
