

Insurance Commissioner, or other proper officer of its own state or nation, with his certificate that the company is entitled to assume risks and issue policies therein; second, a power of attorney appointing a citizen of this State, resident within this State, the agent or attorney for the company, upon whom process of law can be served; there must also be filed with the Insurance Commissioner a certified copy of the vote or resolution of the directors appointing such attorney, which appointment shall continue until another attorney be substituted. And said writing or power of attorney shall stipulate and agree on the part of the company making the same, that any lawful process against said company which is served on such agent, shall be of the same legal force and validity as if served on such company or association within this State; and also, that in case of the death or absence of the attorney so appointed, service of process may be made upon the Insurance Commissioner of this State; and such power of attorney cannot be revoked or modified (except that a new one may be substituted), so long as any policy or liability remains outstanding against such company in this State. The term "process," used above, shall be held and deemed to include any writ, summons or order whereby any action, suit or proceeding shall be commenced, or which shall be issued in or upon any action, suit or proceedings by any court, officer, or magistrate. Third, a statement of the condition of the company on the thirty-first day of December next preceding, under oath of the president or vice-president of the company, with that of the secretary or actuary as hereinafter provided for. Fourth, a certificate of the appointment of a general agent of the company for this State, and a list of its agents authorized to transact business for said company within this State, and no certificate of authority as hereinafter described shall be issued to any person or persons not so designated by the company as agent, except in the case of solicitors of life insurance, who may be designated by the general agent of the company for this State.
