

COUNTY SURVEYOR.

21. The surveyor of Garrett county shall be entitled to charge and receive for his individual services in any of the duties pertaining to his office a per diem of five dollars for each day he may be engaged in the performance of such duties, and when the same shall be required by the person for whom the services shall be rendered, he shall state his account of such services under oath.

CRIER.

22. The commissioners of said county shall levy annually to the crier of the Circuit Court for said county, two dollars per day for his services as such crier, and the collector shall pay said crier at the close of each session of the court for his services during said session.

DEER.

23. No person shall kill or destroy or try to kill or destroy any wild deer in said county, except during the months of October and November; and no person shall at any time catch or destroy any wild deer by running or chasing them by dog or dogs, and for every violation of this act the offender shall on conviction pay a fine of not less than twenty-five nor more than fifty dollars.

Shall not kill deer.  
Penalty.

24. The possession by any person within the county of any deer meat, except during the said months of October and November, shall be *prima facie* evidence that the same was killed within the limits of said county, and that the person so in possession killed the same.

Evidence.

25. Said fines shall be collected as provided in section seven of this article.

Fines collected.

26. It shall be the duty of the constable of the several election districts of the county to arrest all persons whom they may see violating any of the sections of this act, and take them before the nearest justice of the peace to be dealt with according to law.
