SEC. 32. *And be it enacted*, That all persons entitled to vote for delegates to the General Assembly of Maryland, and who have resided within the corporate limits of said town of Centreville for twelve months preceding an election for Town Commissioners, or who hold taxable property in said town and pay taxes thereon, shall, at the court-house in said town, on the first Monday in April of the year eighteen hundred and seventy-eight, and every second year thereafter, elect by ballot three persons, residents and holding real estate in said town above the value of three hundred dollars, as Town Commissioners, who shall be a body corporate under the name and style of "The Town Commissioners of Centreville."

Have charge  
and control.

SEC. 55. *And be it enacted*, That the Town Commissioners of Centreville shall have charge, control and management of the market-house in the town of Centreville and full power and authority to enact rules and regulations for the sale in said town of all meats, poultry, fish, fruits, vegetables and other provisions therein, and to enforce all such rules and regulations by fines, penalties and forfeitures.

May levy.

SEC. 71. *And be it enacted*, That the Commissioners of Centreville may adopt the county assessment and valuation of all real and personal property in said town, and may annually, between the first day of April and the first day of May, levy on the property so assessed, such sums of money, not to exceed thirty cents for every hundred dollars, in any one year, as they may deem necessary for the improvement and expenses of said town.
