Made a free bridge.
Appoint keeper.
 SEC. 3. *And be it further enacted,* That from and after the time said bridge shall be purchased as aforesaid, it shall be under the management and control of said County Commissioners, and shall be made a free bridge for the citizens and residents of Talbot county; and during the month of April of each year said commissioners shall appoint a keeper for said bridge, at a salary of two hundred and fifty dollars per annum.

CHAPTER 191.

AN ACT to repeal chapter one hundred and eighty-one, of the acts of eighteen hundred and seventy-two, entitled an act to repeal section twenty-one, of article seven, of the Code of Public Local Laws, entitled "Carroll County," sub-title "Justices of the Peace and Constables," and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Repealed and re-enacted.
 SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That section twenty-one, of chapter one hundred and eighty-one, of the laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-two, be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows:

Justices of the peace and constables for Carroll county.
 SEC. 21. There shall be the following number of justices of the peace and constables for Carroll county: for election district number one, four justices of the peace and two constables; for election district number two, three justices of the peace and two constables; for election district number three, three justices of the peace and two constables; for election district number four, four justices of the peace and three constables; for election district
