CHAPTER 194.

AN ACT to repeal sections nine and ten of chapter four hundred and twenty-four of the acts of eighteen hundred and sixty-eight, entitled "An act to incorporate the town of Berlin, in Worcester county," and to re-enact the same with amendments.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That sections nine and ten of chapter four hundred and twenty-four of the acts of eighteen hundred and sixty-eight, entitled "An act to incorporate the town of Berlin, in Worcester county," be and the same are hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows :

Fines and forfeitures.

Power to remit fines, &c

9. All fines and forfeitures under the ordinances of said corporation may be recovered before a justice of the peace by warrant, judgment and commitment to the public jail of Worcester county, in the same manner that commitments are made for fines imposed by the Circuit Courts of this State on conviction for misdemeanor, but the said commissioners, or a majority of them, shall have power at any time to remit or release the said fines, penalties, forfeitures and costs, or any part thereof, at their discretion ; but any party who shall be fined or subjected to any
