

debted to the persons in their employ, or to furnishers of any raw material, in the aggregate sum of twenty-five dollars, and shall neglect or refuse to pay the same for the space of thirty days, the Circuit Court for said county, as a court of equity, or the judge thereof in vacation, shall, upon the petition of the employees or furnishers of raw material, or any number of them, appoint a receiver to take charge of the affairs of such individual, association or body corporate, with a view to their liquidation and settlement under the authority of the court.

Appoint receiver.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage, but shall not affect in any manner any suit, cause or proceeding heretofore commenced or now pending under the provisions of the sections hereby amended.

CHAPTER 321.

AN ACT to repeal section two hundred and ten of article ten of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Dorchester County," sub-title "Sheriff," as enacted by chapter two hundred and sixteen of the acts passed at the January session, eighteen hundred and sixty-eight, and to re-enact the same as follows:

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That section two hundred and ten of article ten of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Dorchester County," sub-title "Sheriff," as enacted by chapter two hundred and sixteen of the acts passed at the January session, eighteen hundred and sixty-eight, be and the same is hereby repealed, and the following enacted in lieu thereof:

SEC. 210. The sheriff of Dorchester county shall not be entitled to receive more than thirty cents a
