

to issue the bonds of the city for the amount so funded, payable at such time and bearing such rate of interest, not exceeding six per centum per annum, as the said Mayor and City Council of Baltimore shall provide by ordinance, to be adopted at the present session of the City Council of Baltimore; provided that the said bonds shall not be issued unless the ordinance which the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore is hereby authorized to enact shall be approved by the votes of a majority of the legal voters of the said city, cast at the time and places to be appointed by said ordinance in the provision for submitting the same to the legal voters of the city as required by section seven, article eleven of the constitution of Maryland; provided, however, that said bonds shall not be sold at less than par.

CHAPTER 329.

AN ACT to authorize and direct the County Commissioners of Harford county to repay to George A. Merritt and M. H. Keene the sum of fifty-one dollars and fifty-eight cents, the same having been erroneously paid by them on their county taxes.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the County Commissioners of Harford county be and are hereby authorized and directed to levy for and pay the sum of fifty-one dollars and fifty-eight cents to George A. Merritt and M. H. Keene, which sum was erroneously paid by said Merritt and Keene in excess of their county taxes actually due.

SEC. 2. *Be it enacted*, That this act take effect from the date of its passage. In force.
