

CHAPTER 422.

AN ACT to authorize the County Commissioners of Worcester county to open a road in said county, and to permit gates to be placed across the same.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the County Commissioners of Worcester county are hereby authorized and empowered to open a road from such point as they may deem proper in the ninth election district of said county, near the town of Berlin, on the public road which is contiguous to the farm occupied by Peter C. Davis, so as to intersect the public road leading from Newark to Queponco, or so much thereof as they may deem proper, and in their discretion to permit any person or persons to place gates across the same; provided that the right to compensation for damages or injury sustained by any person by opening said road shall not be impaired by this act.

Open a road and place gates across.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 423.

AN ACT to change a part of the dividing line between the fourth and fifth election districts of St. Mary's county.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That that portion of the fourth election district of St. Mary's county lying north of a straight line starting from a point at which the road leading from the Three Notch road to St. Joseph Church, known as the Forest Hall road, intersects the said Three Notch road, running thence north eighty-eight degrees, west three and one-half miles, to the junction of Sothoron's run with the north-
