CHAPTER 65.

AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money to pay Walter B. Brooks, assignee in bankruptcy of Stirling, Ahrens & Co., for the rent of certain warehouses in the city of Baltimore, used as State Tobacco Warehouses.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the sum of thirty-six hundred and twenty-five dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated to pay Walter B. Brooks, assignee in bankruptcy of Stirling, Ahrens & Co., for rent of certain warehouses in the city of Baltimore, used as State Tobacco Warehouses; and the Comptroller is hereby directed to issue his warrant upon the Treasurer for the sum of thirty-six hundred and twenty-five dollars, payable to the order of said Walter B. Brooks, assignee in bankruptcy of Stirling, Ahrens & Co.
