Senate bill entitled an Act to repeal section 5, of Chapter 268, of the Acts of 1890, entitled an Act to provide for the appointment of Boards of County School Commissioners for Calvert and St. Mary's counties, so far as it relates to Calvert county, and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Senate bill entitled an Act to repeal Chapter seventy-three, of the Acts of eighteen hundred and eighty-two, entitled an Act to add additional sections to the Code of Public Local Laws, Article , entitled "Garrett County," enacted by the Act of eighteen hundred and seventy-eight, Chapter 108; said sections to be sub-titled "Thistles," to come in after sub-section seventy-five in said Act, to be numbered "75 A," "75 B," "75 C," and to re-enact the same with amendments.
