

Mr. Austin, from a Select Committee, reported favorably,

Senate bill entitled an Act to repeal sections 1 to 27, inclusive, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Dorchester County," sub-title "Alms House," and to enact the following in lieu thereof, giving the commissioners of the county exclusive management of said Alms House.

Which was read the second time, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

Mr. Newman, from a Select Committee, reported favorably,

House bill entitled an Act to authorize and empower the Governor to appoint an additional Justice of the Peace in Election District No. 12, in Frederick county.

Which was read the second time.

Mr. Gorter, from a Select Committee, reported favorably,

House bill entitled an Act to incorporate the Tabb and Jenkins Hardware Company of Baltimore city.

Which was read the second time.

Mr. Wootton, from a Select Committee, reported favorably,

House bill entitled an Act to enable the Board of Trustees of Gaithersburg Methodist Episcopal Church, in the United States of America, of Montgomery county, a religious corporation incorporated under the General Corporation Laws of the State of Maryland, to sell and dispose of certain real estate owned by it in Gaithersburg, in said county.

Which was read the second time.

Mr. Lloyd, from a Select Committee, reported favorably the following bills:

House bill entitled an Act to enlarge the powers of the County Commissioners of Talbot county, to enable them to issue bonds of the county sufficient to raise a sum to take up the bonds of the county issued on account of subscription to the capital stocks of Maryland and Delaware Railroad Company, and maturing on the first day of April, in 1892.
