Senate bill entitled an Act to authorize and require the County Commissioners of Baltimore county to make a special levy of not more than twenty cents on each one dollar of the assessable real estate in the village of Lutherville, in Baltimore county, for the purpose of improving the roads in said village, if twenty-five or more persons owning taxable real estate in said village shall petition therefor.
