House bill, File No. 764, entitled "An Act for the better protection of game birds, song birds, insectivorous birds, in Calvert county and St. Mary's county."

Endorsed: "Read the third time and passed by yeas and nays."

Which was read the first time and referred to Senators Greenwell, Griffith and Wilson.

Also,

House bill, File No. 758, entitled "An Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments section 9 of Article 6 of the Code of Public Local Laws, title 'Caroline County,' sub-title 'Almshouse,' and to add three new sections to the said Article 6, to be known as 'Section 9 A and 9 B,' to come in immediately after section 9 and section 10 A, to come in immediately after section 10."

Endorsed: "Read the third time, and passed by yeas and nays."

Which was read the first time, and referred to Senators Roe, Dixon and Kirwan.

Also,

House bill, File No. 754, entitled "An Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments, section 236 of Article 22, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title 'Washington County,' sub-title 'Hancock,' as enacted by chapter 478 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, of the year 1892, providing for the assessment, levy and collection of taxes in Hancock, Maryland, for municipal purposes."

Endorsed: "Read the third time and passed by yeas and nays."

Which was read the first time and referred to Senators Betts, Lewis and Palmer.
