#### REPORTS OF SELECT COMMITTEES.

Senate bill entitled “An Act to repeal chapter 76 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, of the Acts of 1902, entitled ‘An Act to repeal sections 94 to 112, of Article 23 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title ‘Wicomico County,’ sub-title ‘Revenue and Taxes,’ as repealed, amended and re-enacted by chapter 398 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, session of 1894, providing for the collection of taxes in Wicomico county, and election of treasurer, and to re-enact the same with amendments.’”
