

Chapter 42.

An Act to forbid the erection or alteration of any building in Baltimore city, except churches, within one block of the Washington Monument in said city, to a height exceeding a point 70 feet above the surface of the street at the base line of the Washington Monument.

Delivered to Governor, March 8th, 1904.

Chapter 47.

An Act to provide for the donation of a copy of each volume of the Archives of the State of Maryland published by the Maryland Historical Society, to the Washington Free Library.

Delivered to Governor, March 9th, 1904.

Chapter 48.

An Act to formally adopt and legalize the Maryland Flag.

Delivered to Governor, March 9th, 1904.

Chapter 49.

An Act to repeal sections 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 and 8 of chapter 386 of the Acts of 1902, entitled "An Act to amend the charter and extend the powers of the Maryland Casualty Company," and to re-enact the said sections 7 and 8 of said Act with amendments.

Delivered to Governor March 9th, 1904.

Chapter 50.

An Act to appropriate the sum of \$40,000 for the use of the commissioners appointed by the Governor under the authority conferred upon him by the Act of 1902, to represent the State of Maryland at the St. Louis Louisiana Purchase Exposition, to be held at St. Louis, Missouri, in the year 1904.

Delivered to Governor, March 9th, 1904.

Chapter 51.

An Act to give power to the Board of Trustees of the Fifth Regiment Armory to rent the Fifth Regiment Armory temporarily, and to authorize the City of Baltimore to provide temporary quarters for the Fifth Regiment Infantry, Maryland National Guard.

Delivered to Governor, March 9th, 1904.
