

Chapter 155.

An Act to authorize and direct the Comptroller of the State Treasury and the County Commissioners of Baltimore County, respectively to refund to George Brehm and Henry A. Brehm co-partners trading as George Brehm and Son money paid by them for liquor license granted to Amon Dorsey for the year 1903-1904 which license was never taken from the clerk's office of the Circuit Court of said county.

Chapter 156.

An Act to incorporate the Cecil County Bar and Law Library Association, and to provide means for maintaining the same.

Chapter 158.

An Act to authorize the Board of County School Commissioners of Dorchester county to pay, in their discretion, to Thomas I. Wright, of said county, the sum of two hundred dollars with interest from the 22d day of October, 1892, for money paid by him to the said board for certain real estate.

Chapter 160.

An Act providing for the repairing, improving and building an addition to the Cambridge Female Seminary Building and providing heating apparatus therefor, in the town of Cambridge, Dorchester county, Maryland, and to authorize the Board of County School Commissioners of said county to borrow money for the purpose of repairing and improving said building, building an addition thereto and providing heating apparatus therefor by issuing bonds to be indorsed by the County Commissioners of Dorchester county, and authorizing said County Commissioners to levy taxes on the assessable property of said county to redeem said bonds.
