House bill, File No. 146, entitled "An Act to refund to the Montgomery County Telephone Company, of Gaithersburg, Maryland, a certain amount of county tax paid in error."

Endorsed: "Read the third time and passed by yeas and nays."

Which was read the first time, and referred to Senators Jones, Gorman and Wilson.

Also,

House bill, File No. 122, entitled "An Act to appropriate a sum of money to defray the expenses of the interment of the bodies of deceased soldiers, sailors and marines who served in the United or Confederate States, Army or Navy, between the years 1861-1865."

Endorsed: "Read the third time, and passed by yeas and nays."

Which was read the first time, and referred to the Committee on Finance.

Also,

House bill, File No. 150, entitled "An Act to amend the charter and grant additional powers to the Woman's College of Baltimore, a corporation incorporated under the General Laws of Maryland, as amended by an Act of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at the January Session in the year 1890, chapter 325."

Endorsed: "Read the third time, and passed by yeas and nays."

Which was read the first time, and referred to the Committee on Corporations.
