Strike out the following after the word State, in section 1 "In the Counties of Somerset, Wicomico, Dorchester, Talbot, Caroline, Worcester, Queen Anne's, Kent, Calvert, Anne Arundel, Charles and St. Mary's in the State of Maryland."

Which amendment was rejected.

Mr. Gadd offered the following:

AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

Section 11, line 2 of the typewritten amendment of committee as reported. After the word "of" strike out "July, nineteen hundred and four," and in lieu thereof substitute the words "January, nineteen hundred and five."

Which amendment was rejected.

The question then recurring upon the original amendment.

It was adopted.
