

The President distributed the following message received from the House of Delegates:

Senate bill, File No. 18, entitled "An Act to repeal section 85 L of Article 23 of the Code of Public General Laws, title 'Corporations,' sub-title 'General Regulations,' as enacted by the Acts of 1892, chapter 109, and to re-enact the same with amendments."

Endorsed: "Read the third time, and passed by yeas and nays."

Also,

Senate bill, File No. 78, entitled "An Act to add one new section to Article 56 of the Code of Public General Laws of the State of Maryland, said section to be known as 'Section 83 A,' for the purpose of prohibiting the issuing of licenses for the sale of liquor or intoxicating beverages of whatsoever kind on the Potomac river or upon the property of the Chesapeake and Ohio Canal Company, within the State of Maryland."

Endorsed: "Read the third time and passed by yeas and nays as amended."

AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

Amend title to read after the words "Chesapeake and Ohio Canal," "within Allegany and Washington counties in the State of Maryland."

Amend bill by adding to section 1 "That this Act shall not be construed to apply to lessees of properties from the Chesapeake and Ohio Canal Company."
