CHAPTER 193.

AN ACT to incorporate the Smithsburg Savings Insti- Passed May
 tution. 11, 1853.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly* Incorporated
of Maryland, That Isaac Gehr, Doctor E. Bishop,
 Lewis Trittle, Joseph Garver, John Welty, Philip Os-
 wald, George Pearson, Henry Smith, A. C. Martin, J.
 S. Besore, Adam Vogle, William Adams, Henry W.
 Lyday, Levi Leister, Frederick Unger and all, and
 every other person hereafter becoming members of the
 Smithsburg Savings Institution, in the manner here-
 after mentioned, shall be, and are hereby created
 and made a corporation or body politic, by the name
 and style of the Smithsburg Savings Institution, and
 by that name shall have succession, and be capable by
 law, to hold and dispose of real and personal property
 by deed or otherwise, to sue and be sued, plead and be
 implead, answer and defend, and be answered and de-
 fended in courts of law and equity, or in any other
 place whatsoever, and to receive and make all deeds,
 transfers, contracts, conveyances and grants whatsoever,
 and to make, have and use a common seal, and the
 same to change and renew at pleasure, and generally
 to do every other act or thing necessary to carry into
 effect the provisions of this act.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That there shall be a Meeting to be

 sons first above named, or a majority of them, shall ap-
