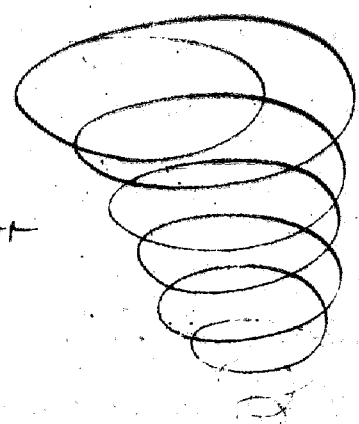

This Indenture made the 15th day of January in the fifteenth year of the Dominion of the Right Honourable Charles absolute Lord and Proprietary of the Province of Maryland and Avalon Lord Barron of Baltimore gra and in the year of our Lord God One thousand six hundred and ninety one between George Carter of Somerset County in the Province of Maryland Planter and Mary his wife of the one part and Henry Mayle of New York Merchant of the other part with witnesses that whereas by deed of grant, under the great Seal used in the Province of Maryland for granting of Lands bearing date at St. Maries. Know you that whereas Col. William: Stouens of Somerset had a warrant for five thousand acres granted the third of May, One thousand six hundred and eighty three and had surveyed for him a tract of Land for three hundred and fifty acres called Carvers Lodge, all whose right title and interest of give and to the said his the said William Stouens hath made over to George Carter as aforesaid as a Ballot for the same may more fully appear as upon the terms and
