S. E. three hundred and eighty parts thence N. N. E. One hundred and eighty parts, and from thence with a right line drawn to the first boundary. Containing and now laid out for three hundred and fifty acres of Land more or less according to the Certificate of Survey there of taken and returned in the Land Office at the City of St. Maries and there remaining on Record at the Ballot more fully declared, together with all rights profits and priviledges thereunto belonging - Royal mind Excepted. Now this Indenture further witnesseth, that the above named George Carter and Mary his wife for the Consideration of six thousand pounds of lawful good sound Merchants in hand paid by the within named Henry Mayle for the purchase and delivery hereof whereof, and whereunto the said George Carter and Mary his wife do acknowledge themselves fully satisfied and paid, and do of and for every part or parcels hereof acquit and discharge the aforesaid Henry Mayle, his heirs Executors Administrators and Assigns for ever, and in these presents have given granted bargained and sold, alienated enfeoffed and confirmed, unto the said Henry Mayle and to his heirs and Assigns for ever, all the aforesaid Land aforesaid called Carter's Lodge, as also the aforesaid George Carter and Mary his wife for themselves their heirs Executors Administrators and Assigns, grant bargain and sell as aforesaid to the said Henry Mayle and his heirs for ever, all and singular the Ballots, Indentures, Counterparts, writings Certificates or any other writing or way whatsoever, with all and singular the promises thereunto pertaining or belonging unto him the said Henry Mayle and his heirs to keep the said my alienation or sale good and free from former sales, grants, mortgages or incumbrances whatsoever from our selves our heirs Executors Administrators and Assigns for ever.
