This is the Order of Court dated the twenty day of November in the fourth year of their Majesties Reign William and Mary by the grace of God of England Scotland France & Ireland King & Queen defenders of the faith &c. in the year of our Lord God One thousand six hundred ninety and One.

Know all men by these presents that we Mary: Hoar in: Thomas: Jones in: Joseph: Gray — of the County of Somerset and Province of Mary Land, do acknowledge and confess our selves to owe and are indebted unto their Majesties William: & Mary King & Queen over England &c. the just sum of five hundred pounds — Sterling money of England which we promise to pay to their Majesties or to their Justices for the use of the Exchequer of the said Kingdom of England within the space of six months next after the date of these presents of the said County Court. And for the true performance of the same to be well and truly paid we bind us and each of us our Heirs Executors and Assigns, jointly & severally in and for the words to their said Majesties or firmly by these presents. In testimony whereof we have hereunto set our hands and seals this 7th day of October in the 3rd year of their Majesties Reign and in the year of our Lord God One thousand six hundred ninety and One.

The Condition of the above Obligation is such that if the above bound Mary: Hoar, do well & truly observe and satisfy all and every the will of William: Hoar deceased, which will bears to date the twenty eighth day of March Anno Domini 1691: As well as to pay all and every the debts of the said deceased, upon Order had and obtained from their Majesties Justices of the Peace in Court sitting as also to observe the laws and Statutes in the said letters of Deministracion to her granted. And lastly to keep harmless and indemnify the Justices of the Peace of the said County for prebent of Wills and granting of Deministracion and all other the Officers therein concerned. That then this Obligation to be void and of none effect, otherwise to be remain in full power force and virtue.

Whereas William: Broston of the said County hath deceased, we do therefore give and grant unto you the said Broston full power and authority to administer all and singular the goods Chattels and Credits of the said deceased and to demand receive and levy and in legall manner require and receive, all and all manner of debt and debts due and owing to the said deceased, and well and faithfully to dispose the same. And out of the goods Chattels and Credits of the said deceased which have may or shall come to your hands or possession, well and truly to pay the debts due by the said deceased so far forth as the same will hereunto extend, and the law will charge you, according to the true value of the sum thereof. And having first taken your Oath well and truly to show the same due to make or cause to be made a true and perfect Inventory of all and singular the goods Chattels and Credits of the said deceased, which have may or shall come to your hands
